A degree in Catholic theology, a Ph.D and positive evaluation as a junior professor or equivalent academic achievement (e.g. Habilitation) or significant post-doctoral research contributions in dogmatics and history of dogma and teaching experience are as much required as the willingness to participate in the self-governing bodies of Ruhr-University Bochum.

We expect:

- strong commitment to academic teaching at graduate and undergraduate level;
- readiness to participate in interdisciplinary research;
- willingness and ability to attract external funding;
- readiness to contribute to joint research projects in the department.
